#### STEM Grants

• Funding available year round for projects which allow students to use their creativity and imagination and develop other 21st century skills such as collaboration and teamwork, critical thinking, and problem solving. They provide students/ teachers with opportunities to employ STEM (science, technology, engineering, math).

### Teacher Toolkit Grants

• The Teacher's Tool Kit Grant lets Pre-K-12 teachers fund classroom projects that aim to foster creativity and critical thinking in students all year round. Grants are awarded based on financial need, a description of how the project meets the students' needs and the number of students who will be involved.

### Classroom Impact Grants

• These classroom grants are to help fund innovative, engaging, and transformative projects that really make a difference for your students. These grants are submitted in May and supplies will be available to start the next school year.
