Founded in 1991, the CCEF has provided more than \$2.8 million in student scholarships, teacher grants, system demonstration grants, and donor-defined projects through a combination of fundraising and endowment income since its inception.

 - These annual scholarships are in recognition of outstanding competency teachers who work in Clarke County Public Schools to assist these teachers in furthering their education
 - Application online, due September 30th
- **Apple Federal Credit Union Foundation Scholarship**
 - 1 \$500 scholarship available to CCHS Seniors OR Teaching Assistants who plan to become classroom teachers

 - Same deadline as student scholarship applications
- **New Teacher Reimbursement**
 - \$50 reimbursements available to NEW CCPS teachers and
 - \$100 reimbursements available to 1st year teachers

TEACHER GRANT PROGRAMS

- **STEM Grants**
 - Funding available year round for projects which allow students to use their creativity and imagination and develop other 21st century skills such as collaboration and teamwork, critical thinking, and problem solving. They provide students/ teachers with opportunities to employ STEM (science, technology, engineering, math).
- **Teacher Toolkit Grants**
 - The Teacher's Tool Kit Grant lets Pre-K-12 teachers fund classroom projects that aim to foster creativity and critical thinking in students all year round. Grants are awarded based on financial need, a description of how the project meets the students' needs and the number of students who will be involved.
- **Classroom Impact Grants**
 - These classroom grants are to help fund innovative, engaging, and transformative projects that really make a difference for your students. These grants are submitted in May and supplies will be available to start the next school year.



OTHER OPPORTUNITIES

- **Evan Robb Professional Book Study Fund**
 - Funding available for teachers to participate in professional learning book studies
 - Application online, rolling deadline
- **Clyff Hill Memorial Fund**
 - These funds will help publish and print the CCHS IB English Culminating Book of Poetry which can be found in the CCHS library.
- **John Friant, Sr. Dictionary Fund**
 - Dictionaries purchased for every 3rd grade student in Clarke County
- **Richard M. Lewis Academic Access Fund**
 - Funded to provide Kajeets, a broadband internet device, to those students who are not able to access internet in their homes since.
- **VA Star**
 - The Virginia Student Training and Refurbishment Program is a program in schools all across the Commonwealth of Virginia. These students refurbish computers and work toward IT industry standard certifications. The program helps teach students to refurbish surplus computer hardware from government agencies and private companies. The refurbished computers are donated to families, organizations, and school districts at no cost.
