Step 2: Choose Your Fund Type

OPTION 1: Purpose-Restricted Fund or Scholarship

Short-Term Impact

- Minimum Required Gift: \$500
- Funds are used until fully spent.
- You choose the focus—scholarship criteria, a specific classroom need, extracurricular program, or student initiative.
- Management Fee: 2% annually
- Great for memorial funds, annual giving, or one-time projects.

Fund or scholarship concludes when all funds are awarded or expended.

Where Do the Fees Go?

To ensure responsible stewardship of every fund and scholarship, CCEF charges a small annual fee to support:

OPTION 2: Endowment Fund or Scholarship

Long-Term Legacy

- Minimum Initial Gift: \$12,500
- Funds are invested; only earnings are used each year.
- The original gift remains intact, supporting students in perpetuity.
- Management Fee: 1% annually
- Ideal for donors looking to create a lasting legacy in Clarke County.

Annual awards or disbursements are made through investment income.or expended.

- Annual independent audit
- Professional bookkeeping
- CPA oversight and financial reporting

Step 3: Customize Your Fund or Scholarship

- Choose a name (honor/memorial or donor-named)
- Define focus or eligibility criteria
- Set award amount or funding purpose
- CCEF manages distribution, promotion, and (if applicable) recipient selection in partnership with Clarke County Public Schools.
