Dear Students, Parents, Educators, and Supporters:

**T**his year we have had the privilege of celebrating 30 years as an organization: 30 years of serving as a lifeline to the Clarke County Public Schools, 30 years of building a brighter future for our students, 30 years of offering incredible opportunity, post graduation to our students, AND 30 years of serving as the glue which secures our public schools with our community supporters and businesses in the most incredible way possible.

In those 30 years, we have offered thousands of hours of volunteer efforts, hundreds of thousands of dollars in student scholarships, and even more in the form of grants and opportunities for our schools. We have worked incredibly hard, with the support of countless community members and businesses, to help our schools succeed. And in doing so, our Clarke County community is stronger. Every single Clarke County resident benefits when our public schools thrive.

We are proud of where we have been, proud of where we are, and proud of where we are going. This year, we have offered over \$53,000 in grant funding to educators which included a \$20,000 grant for virtual reality headsets for our elementary students; we partnered with the Shenandoah Valley Discovery Museum to provide unique opportunities for our students; and offered support to our teachers so they do not have to buy important materials out of their own pockets. We received a \$35,000 Good Neighbor Grant from the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation to help us bring world renowned authors to visit our students during the 2022-2023 school year and ignite a Love of Literacy in their hearts. We were able to offer more in student scholarship funding than in any other time in our 30 year history!

We also were able to host some amazingly successful fundraisers including our Fore the Kids Golf Scramble, Our 24th Annual Gala, the Thank A Teacher Campaign, and Employee Giving Campaign. So many community supporters and sponsors helped make these events a huge success, and for that, we are beyond grateful.
