- One overall selected from finalists: additional \$50 prize



Rules:

(Any departure from rules will result in disqualification.)

- Student must attend Clarke County Public Schools
- Judges will select artwork that is appropriate to share with our diverse community.
- Only one **original** artwork creation may be entered per student.
- Artwork size must be 8.5x11" in LANDSCAPE.
- Artwork must not smudge/smear and must be dry. Any artform may be used (ex: colored pencils, watercolor, crayons, etc.)
- All entries must be received in your school's office by the end of the school day on Monday, December 4th.
- All properly labeled entries will be returned to the student after judging.
- All entries MUST include the Holiday Greeting Card Permission Form below (affixed to the back of the artwork.)
