













Other than Earth, is there any other planet in the solar system that is a home to plants and animals?

A blanket of gases that wraps me and you—in a gentle hug. Hugs are nice.




There are 3 forms of matter: solid, liquid and gas. Name the form of matter for: oxygen, water and ice.

Climate: Seasonal weather over a long time, like thirty years, and in a big region


Climate is not the same as weather. Today Tonight I'm Earth with your weather forecast. Weather: Now or very soon and in a specific place

Climate is seasonal weather over a long period of time, in a big region. Name our 4 seasons and describe their typical weather.








